By enrolling in the Leopard Cyber Academy, the following opportunities will be made available to students:

- Access to Fuel Education's curricula and courses.
- Receive daily online monitoring and assistance by highly qualified teachers and weekly onsite help from the Leopard Cyber Academy mentor.
- **Attend the onsite supervised computer lab weekly with transportation provided by the district to students living in the Liberty Local School District.**
- Receive a loaned personal computer for course work while a student in good standing at Leopard Cyber Academy.
- **Parents will receive weekly progress reports on their child's performance.**
- Eligible to participate in all extra-curricular activities sponsored by the Liberty Local Schools.
- Receive a Liberty Local High School diploma upon graduation.

Academic Integrity

Students who enroll in the Leopard Cyber Academy will be held to the highest standard of academic integrity. These standards include:

- Agreeing to and signing a student agreement form that outlines the student's rights and responsibilities.
- Compliance with the acceptable use of loaned and onsite lab computers and computer lab rules.
- Honesty in all academic matters, as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct, is expected from all students. Any attempt to cheat, plagiarize, falsify information, or receive credit for work you did not do will be considered dishonest behavior and will be dealt with accordingly by the instructor and/or mentor.
- All end of unit exams (summative assessments) will be password-protected and must be completed on-site in the lab in a proctored setting with the mentor present.
- Students will not be permitted to utilize Internet sites such as Google, or any question and answer website to complete assignments and assessments.
